1. Photograph Usage:

Photos taken at Southern Cross Martial Arts may be used for advertising, marketing, instructor training, and educational purposes, including online posts and documents.

2. Member Consent:

No member's name will be used in conjunction with a photo without permission. Permission is obtained verbally as the photo is taken generally and will usually only be in closed groups or Emails etc. For example if they receive an award and we would like to congratulate them.

3. Internet Content:

When uploading content to the internet, we are committed to being mindful of the images shared. We will exercise caution and discretion to ensure that the content aligns with the values of Southern Cross Martial Arts. No distasteful images will be taken, kept or used online by Southern Cross Martial Arts or any of its staff.

4. Parental Photography:

Parents are welcome to take photos during classes, events, or other martial arts activities. However, we kindly request that parents seek permission from the class instructor on the day before capturing any images. They will also be bound by this policy.

5. Respecting Boundaries:

We prioritise the comfort and well-being of our members. If any member expresses discomfort with having their photo taken or shared, we will respect their wishes, and their privacy will be prioritised.
